PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Parents/Carers.

CLASSROOM INFORMATION EVENINGS

We are very much aware that COVID-19 restrictions have limited parent involvement in the life of our school. As a result, we would like to invite you to an information evening to meet your child's teacher/s and hear about your child's learning for the year.

There will be a short presentation from your child's teacher/s and then time to mingle and meet your child's teacher/s and fellow parents from your child's classroom. This will replace the parent teacher conversations that usually take place in Term 1. Please note that you are always welcome to contact your teacher to organise a 1:1 interview if you have a concern.

The nights are spread across a week to keep in line with Covid-19 measures. As a result of each classroom size, we can only invite one parent per family. This is a parent only event. Additionally, parents will be asked to sign in and wear masks while on the school grounds.

School Fees and Statements

Fee statements will be sent home with the eldest student in each family this week. Please check school bags to ensure you don't miss this. All payments received up to and including Friday the 19th February have been recorded and will show on this statement. Please note, students who attended in 2020, received a rebate for their excursion and swimming levies, and this is already included in your current statement balance.

If you have already nominated to set up a payment plan, these are now in place and may have been adjusted to reflect the credit from your 2020 account (if applicable). If you would like to establish a payment plan for the remainder of 2021, using a Credit Card, Bank Account or Centrepay, please request a fee payment option form.

If you have nominated to pay your account directly at the office or via direct deposit into the school account, please note that unless you intend to make a single annual payment (3rd week, term 2), weekly, fortnightly, monthly or termly options should now be initiated.

Be Water Smart

St Anthony's Primary School works in partnership with '*Royal Life Saving Australia*' to deliver the importance of being Water Smart to our students. Royal Life Saving aims to teach 100,000 children each year across Australia to be Water Smart, in order to prevent drowning and increase participation in safe aquatic activity.

The Water Smart Award focuses on

- Water Safety knowledge
- Introduction to resuscitation principles
- Basic reach and throw rescue techniques

Water Safety Tips

- 1. Never swim alone always have a buddy
- 2. Always check how deep the water is especially if you cannot see the bottom
- 3. Obey signs, warning flags and lifeguards
- 4. Always wear a life jacket while on a boat
- 5. No running around the pool edge you could easily slip, fall and hurt yourself

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students
- \$225 for secondary school students

ST ANTHONY'S CSEF SCHOOL FEE DISCOUNT -

Please note that families who qualify for CSEF are also eligible for a discount on their School Fees.

\$650 per family for a family with 1 child \$700 per family for a family with 2 or more children

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances. You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools this year.
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.
